At NCAS Peter was both a mentee and a mentor in the STARS Mentoring Program and served as SNC Intern and Staff, helping to make SNC a memorable and positive experience for all who attended. Peter is a servant leader with proven experience of engaging youth and elders in much needed conversations through his organization 10for10. He started 10for10 as a way to unite Black men but has since expanded the mission to be inclusive of women and all people of color. Through 10for10, Peter has led protests, rallies, marches, and service events that have fed thousands of people.

Peter aims to put young people at the forefront of the change taking place in our communities. While at Howard University, Peter was involved in the Andrew Rankin Memorial Chapel, founded the Colorado Club to support students from Colorado and served as the President of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity Inc., Alpha Chapter.
